THE SIGNIFICANCE OF TABNITH IN THE CONTEXT OF CORRESPONDENCE OF HEAVENLY AND EARTHLY SANCTUARY IN EXODUS 25:9, 40

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ABSTRACT

The picture of the heavenly sanctuary/temple is that of a model for the construction of the earthly counterpart. This understanding is conveyed mainly by the concept of π -ice, "pattern, form, or model" in Exod 25:9, 40 or σκιά, "shadow" in Heb 8:5, or ὑπόδειγμα, "copy" in Heb 9:23, 24. It reveals that the heavenly sanctuary/temple functions as the archetype of the earthly temple. In the context of the book of Exodus, π -ice, functions as the model of the sanctuary Moses was to build on the earth. Moses was probably shown the heavenly sanctuary and a "model" of what he had to build upon the earth. The π -ice, also suggests an idiomatic correspondence between the heavenly sanctuary and its earthly counterpart.
